# PUERTO RICO STATE-SUBDIVISION AGREEMENT REGARDING THE DISTRIBUTOR AND JANSSEN SETTLEMENTS

- This State-Subdivision Agreement is made between the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico ("Puerto Rico"), through its Attorney General Domingo Emanuelli, the Municipality of San Juan ("San Juan"), and the undersigned Puerto Rico Municipalities that are also Participating Subdivisions (collectively, the "Participating Subdivisions") to the Distributor Settlement Agreement dated July 21, 2021 ("Distributor Settlement") and the Janssen Settlement Agreement dated July 21, 2021 ("Janssen Settlement").
- This Agreement applies only to San Juan's participation in the Distributor and Janssen Settlements.
- Puerto Rico and the Participating Subdivisions have previously agreed to participate in both the Distributor Settlement and the Janssen Settlements.
- Puerto Rico and the Participating Subdivisions have previously agreed to apply the default allocation defined in Section V of the Distributor and Janssen Settlements.
- Pursuant to the default allocation, the proceeds to be received from the Distributor and Janssen Settlements will be distributed as follows:
  - o 70% of the settlement proceeds will go to an Abatement Fund;
  - o 15% of the settlement proceeds will go to a Subdivision Fund; and
  - o 15% of the settlement proceeds will go to a State Fund.
- Subject to the approval of the Puerto Rico Attorney General and the required number of Participating Subdivisions as set forth in Section V and Exhibit O of the Distributor and Janssen Settlements, the Parties to this Agreement hereby convene as follows:
  - San Juan will agree to participate in the Distributor and Janssen Settlements and will submit two Releases with the Settlement Fund Administrator: one Release for the Distributor Settlement, and one for the Janssen Settlement;
  - The Parties to this Agreement will make best efforts so that the Distributors and Janssen will deem San Juan to be a Participating Subdivision in the Distributor and Janssen Settlements;
  - San Juan will receive 13.8% of the proceeds allocated to the Abatement Fund (which is 70% of the total settlement amount), and will work together with the Settlement Fund Administrator to ensure annual compliance and the proper use of abatement funds, consistent with the purpose of the Abatement Fund and the Distributor and Janssen Settlements;

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- o San Juan will receive 13.8% of the proceeds allocated to the Subdivision Fund (which is 15% of the total settlement amount), and will work together with the Settlement Fund Administrator to ensure annual compliance and the proper use of subdivision funds, consistent with the purpose of the Subdivision Fund and the Distributor and Janssen Settlements;
- The undersigned Participating Subdivisions represent at least 50% of Puerto Rico's population and 15% of Puerto Rico's total number of subdivisions, as required by Exhibit O of the Distributor and Janssen Settlements.
